

UVU Academic Standards Policy

ACADEMIC STANDING	DEFINITION	STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY
GOOD STANDING	When the most recent semester GPA and the cumulative GPA are 2.0 or higher	The student will continue to maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher in order to remain in good standing.
WARNING Includes a registration block	When the most recent semester GPA is below 2.0 and the cumulative GPA is above 2.0	The student must complete the online Academic Standards Warning Workshop. After completing the on-line workshop, the student will meet with their major advisor before being allowed to register for a future semester.
PROBATION Includes a registration block	When the cumulative GPA is below 2.0	The student must complete the on-campus or on-line Academic Success Probation Workshop. After completing the workshop, the student must meet with their major advisor.
CONTINUED PROBATION Includes a registration block	When the cumulative GPA is below 2.0 for the two subsequent semesters.	The student may complete the on-campus or on-line the Academic Success Probation Workshop. After completing the workshop, the student must meet with an Academic Standards Counselor (LC 402) and major advisor. At mid-semester the student will obtain a mid-term grade report form (LC 402), have it signed by each teacher and return it to the Academic Standards Counselor before he/she may register for the next semester.
SUSPENSION Includes registration blocks	When cumulative grades are below 2.0 for a third semester	A student on Suspension is dropped from enrollment. The student must sit out a minimum of one semester, then must petition the Academic Standards Committee (ASC) in order to continue at UVU (forms may be obtained in CACC LC 402, 801-863-8425). The petition must be returned to the Career & Academic Counseling Center (CACC) - LC 402 for review by the Academic Standards Committee by the 1st of each month. Students are encouraged to submit petitions as early as possible; however, the deadlines for submission of petitions are March 1 for Summer, June 1 for Fall, and November 1 for Spring. Any petitions received after the deadline will be reviewed the following semester. As long as the student complies with the committee's guidelines he/she may remain at UVU.
DISMISSAL Includes a registration block	When a student fails to complete the conditions of the Academic Standards Committee	A student who has been dismissed from the institution is immediately dropped from enrollment in all classes. The student must sit out one full calendar year before he/she is eligible to submit a Dismissal Petition. The student may also be required to attend another institution and complete 18 credits with a 2.5 or above GPA. Once the petition is reviewed it will be determined whether or not and under what condition the student may return to the institution.
