ADMISSION/REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- STEP 1 Complete and submit application; pay nonrefundable \$35 application fee. An acceptance letter will follow.
- STEP 2 Submit high school transcripts verifying graduation or certification of high school completion. Transcripts may be sent directly from the high school or submitted with the application. If you intend to apply for federal financial aid, proof of high school graduation is required.
- STEP 3 Submit **official** College/University transcripts from all previous institutions.
- STEP 4 Submit ACT or SAT scores prior to registration for classes. If test scores do not meet requirement for English and Math placement, student will be required to take the new student assessment test. For more information see the following web site: www.uvsc.edu/testingervices.
- STEP 5 Participate in Pre-Advisement (Web Start) session. For specific information regarding Web Start, contact this web site: www.uvsc.edu/orientation/webstart2/.
