Graduation Requirements

1. Completion of minimum of 125 semester credits.
2. Overall 3.0+ GPA or above with no grade lower than a C or better in major required content courses and no grade lower than a B- in licensure and methods courses.
3. Residency hours: minimum of 30 credits completed through course attendance at UVU; at least 10 hours earned in the last 45 hours.
4. Completion of general education and specified departmental requirements.
5. Successful completion of at least 1 Global/Intercultural course.
