- 1) **PPST: Praxis I** exam minimum scores - Reading: 170, Mathematics: 173. (Allow 3-4 wks for scoring)

- 2) Successful **Completion** of all General Education requirements, 2 Pre-professional education courses, and where possible, the majority of content area courses.
- 3) **GPA** of 2.75 or higher.
- 4) A **group interview** directed by the Secondary Teacher Education Selection and Retention Committee.
