On Sept. 12, 2024, the President's Council approved one policy to enter Stage 1: Policy 104 *Advisory Boards*. They also approved compliance changes to Policy 646 *Faculty Appeals for Retention, Tenure, and Promotion* in response to Utah House Bill 438. Policy 101 *Policy on Policies* is currently in Stage 2.
