GE as required by R470

GE Core

- Written Communication (6 credits)
- Quantitative Literacy (3-4 credits)
- American Institutions (3-6 credits)

GE Breadth areas

- Students are required to complete at least 15 credits within five different GE Breadth Areas, with at least one course to be taken from each of the following Breadth Areas:

Arts

Humanities

Life Sciences

Physical Sciences

Social and Behavioral Sciences

- *Minimum of 27 credits & maximum of ~~39~~ 30

- *Transfer is determined by the ~~receiving~~ sending institution
