

PROPOSED OPTIONS

- 1. Maintain current requirements
- 2. Reduce general education credits to the state 30 hours minimum requirement. (no requirements beyond state minimum)
 - 3. Alter requirements to include different courses or potential course options within categories.
 - 4. Provide a different proposal with a clear explanation of how it addresses the critical question.

- R470 (30 credit hours, Math, English, American Institutions, distribution courses)









