**Presentation on Employee and Student Survey on GE at UVU**

- Taylor Lovell from Institutional Research presented results of the student and employee surveys ([link to slides](#)).
- The overall findings show that students have a decent understanding of which courses at UVU are part of General Education. Slightly less is their understanding of the purpose of GE courses.
- Half of employees and a little more than half of students believe that UVU's GE requirements are achieving their mission (as described in the GE task force charge).

**Presentation from GE Review Task Force Chair, Evelyn Porter**

- Chair Porter presented on who our students are, past ideas about GE that have been considered and reminded everyone of the charge and the proposed options ([link to slides](#)).
- The group discussed restraints such as USHE Policy R470, transferability and faculty workload.
- There was a discussion around why UVU has adopted the number of GE credits that are currently in place, and student representatives shared that there is a need to articulate some intentionality around the current GE requirements.
