First Year Seminar

Initial Proposal

- Required stand-alone course in GE
- Potentially displace existing GE course(s)
- Focus on the three distinctive UVU offerings
 - Ethics & Values
 - Health & Fitness for Life
 - Third Science

First Year Seminar

Process

- Need for transparency and fairness
- Data gathering
- Invited relevant parties to make the case for their GE offering
- Committee deliberated and pivoted to embedding FYS into existing GE offerings

First Year Seminar

Embedded Model

- Redesigned sections of existing core or distribution courses.
- Hybrid format
- Goals:
 - Enhance key "values, skills, and knowledge" for university life
 - Social connections, mentoring, metacognition, campus engagement, etc.
 - Increase retention and completion
