New Faculty Orientation

Orientation will also feature a diverse panel of faculty colleagues who will offer their advice on how to succeed at UVU.

All Aboard

New full-time tenure track faculty and lecturers continue onboarding throughout fall and spring semester with monthly informative sessions. Faculty learn about departments on campus that support faculty in teaching and their professional careers at UVU.

Adjunct Institute

Adjunct Institute is for new UVU adjunct faculty. New adjuncts learn about policies and procedures relevant to teaching as an adjunct at UVU. The online portion of adjunct institute includes general information about employment at UVU and teaching such as UVID cards, email, support for students, and opportunities for teaching development through the Office of Teaching and Learning. 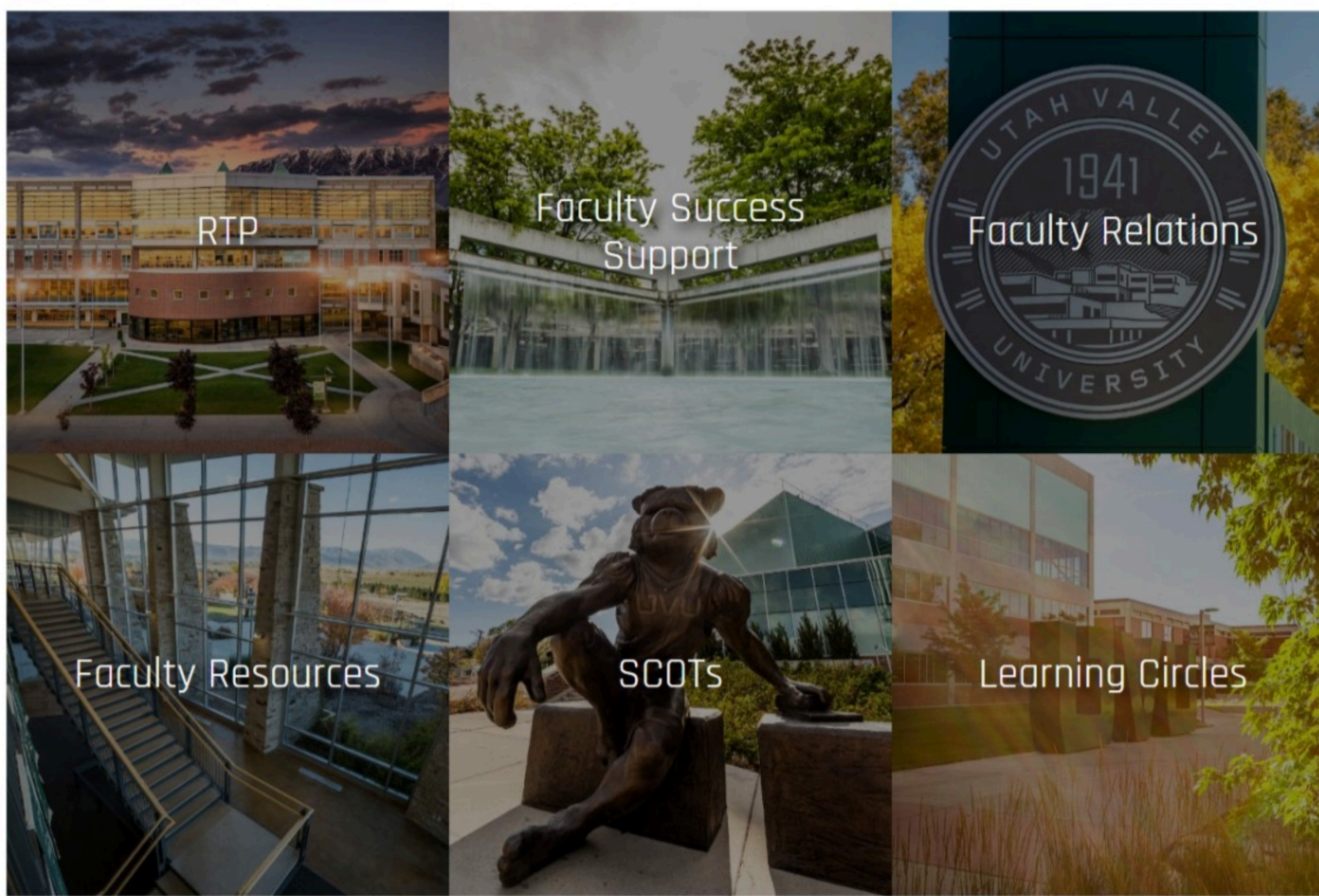
