A LEGACY OF GROWTH AND GENEROSITY



The UVU endowment has seen steady and sustained growth over the past decade, reflecting both the generosity of our donors and our disciplined investment strategy.





Investment Stewardship

Our investment approach is guided by prudence, long-term vision, and alignment with UVU’s mission. We maintain a diversified portfolio that balances growth and stability to ensure every gift continues to make an impact for years to come.



Fund Performance

Through this balanced approach, UVU's endowment achieved a **9.9% one-year return** and a **10-year average return of 8.08%**, exceeding the **NACUBO benchmark** of 6.30% over the same period. *(Performance as of June 30, 2024)*



Endowment Snapshot

At the close of FY2025, UVU managed **344 endowed funds**, each representing a legacy of generosity and belief in the power of education.

Investment Committee


