I realize now that passwords simply need to make sense to me, be easy to use on a variety of devices and be highly memorable.

You may have a different starting point but presently I use the “Be a Nice Human” note as the basis of my passwords because that intention matters to me. I offer this password construction “tip” in case it is helpful to you:

Step 1: Determine the vital elements in the password. UVU Login passwords need to be at least eight characters long, have a lowercase letter, a number, and a special character. (Good luck finding that info by the way!)

Step 2: Decide on some number(s) to use in your new password. Anything meaningful and/or memorable for you.

Step 3: Decide on a special character. I love the equal sign (=) because I believe that being a nice human requires the belief that everyone is doing the best they can with the lives they have been given.


Step 4: Decide on an area of your life that you would like to celebrate, honor or improve. This is almost the most difficult part for me – deciding on ONE basic area of my life. Step 4a: Consolidate your thoughts into ONE word. (This is the MOST difficult part for me.)

Step 5: Type the chosen number/symbol/word combination at least a dozen times (on all of the devices on which you will use it) to make sure it feels right to you.

Step 6: Enjoy your new password.
