



When students make a connection to a school they are more likely to persist, retain, and graduate. Connections can be with other students, with a team or club, or with a staff or faculty member. As advisors, we have opportunities every day to create connections with our students. I want all of my students to know that I know them, not just their name (although that is a great first step!), but a little about them personally. Our Advisor Dashboard is a great way to call students by name, but also to keep track of previous conversations and important facts. While remembering not to write anything too personal for others to see (because we all have access to it), I like to keep some notes that help me remember the student. Sometimes I use abbreviations that only I understand (“saw at WM with sp. Jill [in BMGT at Y] and 2 ch”) to remind me of personal items. I was able to tell this student how nice it was to see them at Wal-Mart with his 2 kids and ask how his wife, Jill, is liking the Business program at BYU. It’s not a big deal, but helps to make a connection.
