

Student Omnibus Survey – Fall 2013

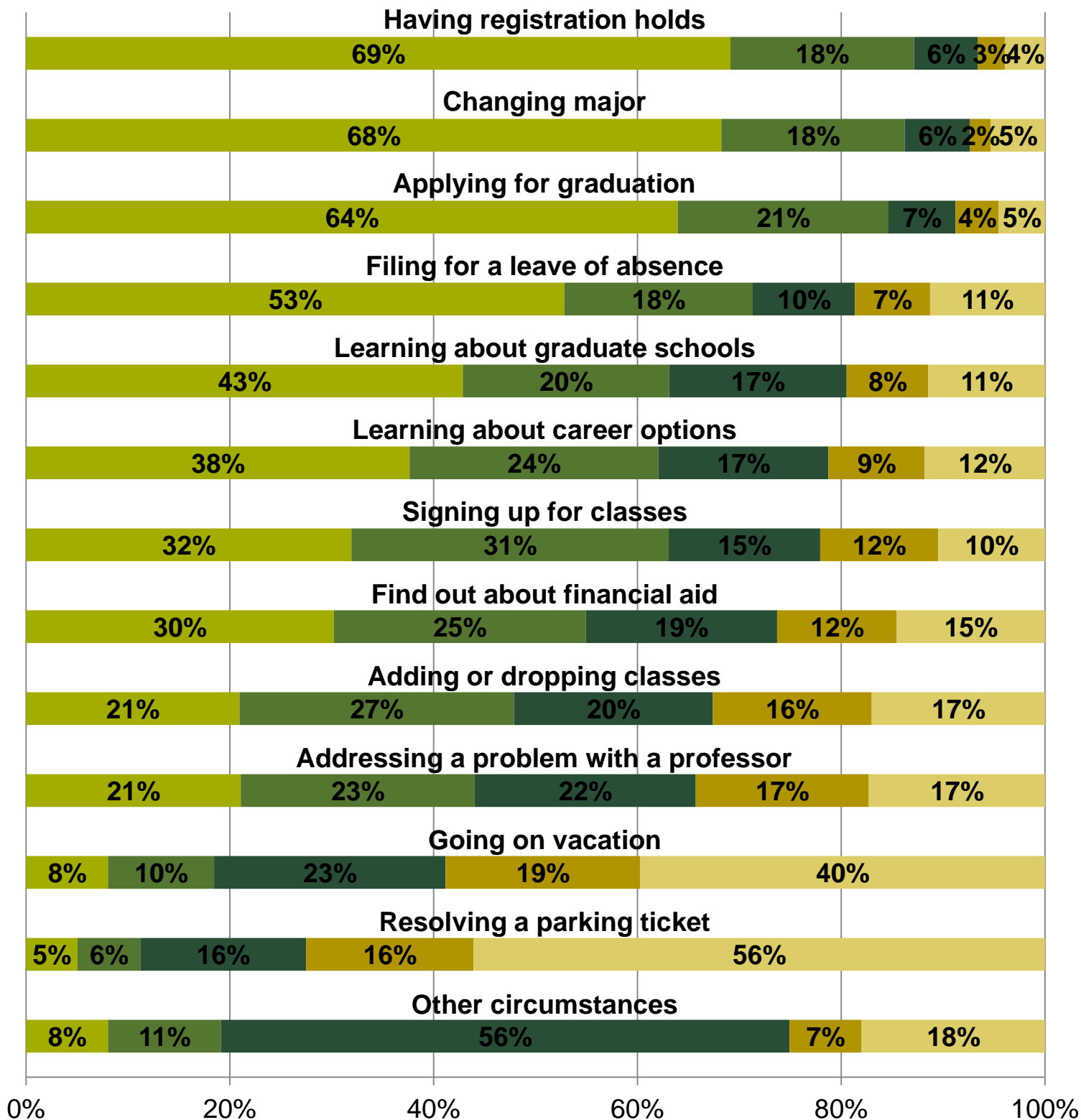
Advising Assessment

The Office of Institutional Research and Information administered this survey to 12,000 UVU students. While 1,733 students started the survey, only 1,282 of them completed it (10.7% completion rate). In order to shorten the survey for students, individual sections of questions were only presented to half of the respondents. The actual number of students responding to individual questions is presented in the following format: (n = #####). The survey was email based and administered between November 11 and November 27, 2013. The margin of error for these results is ± 3.8 percent.

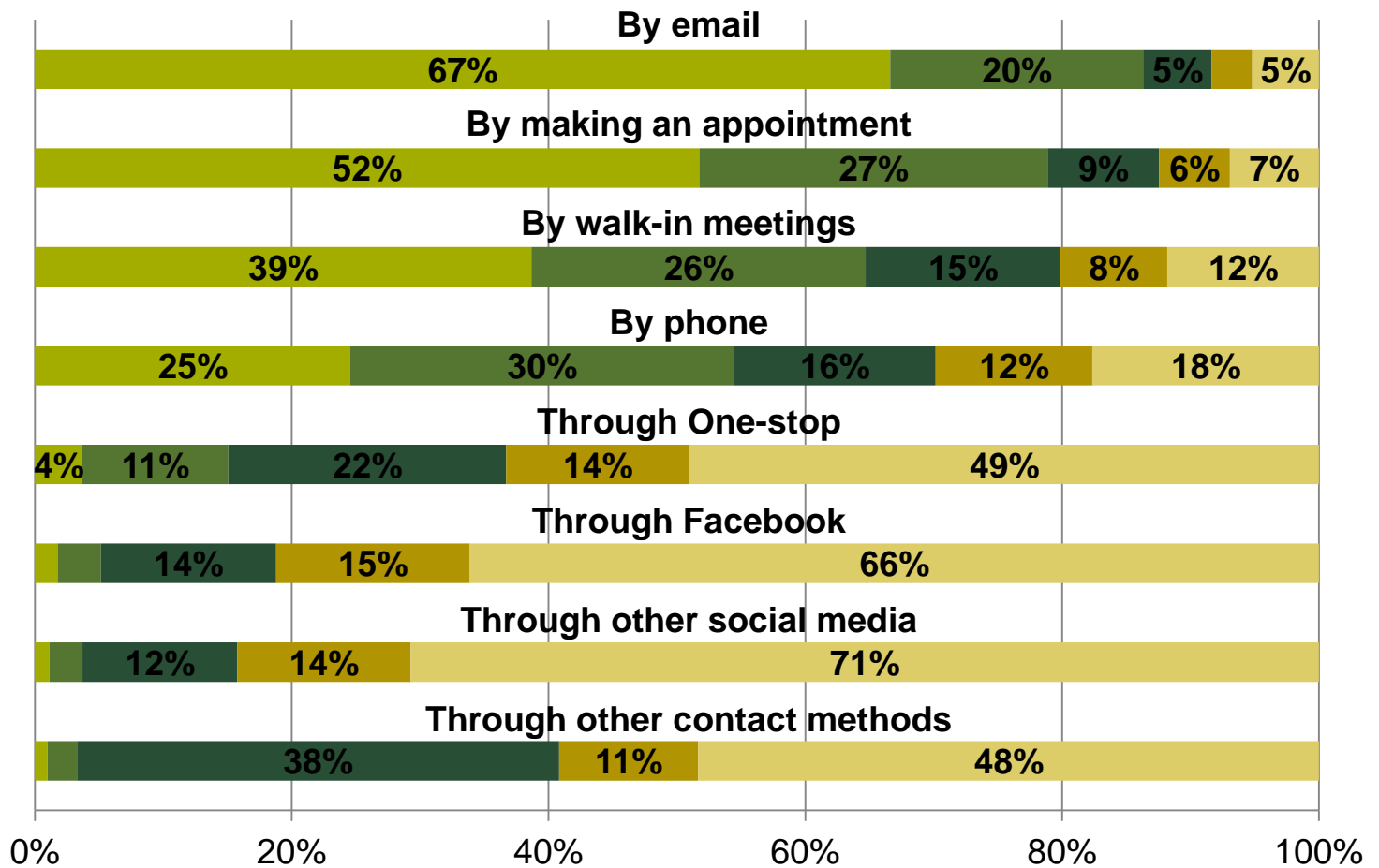
“In what other circumstances are you likely to contact your advisor?” (n = 48)

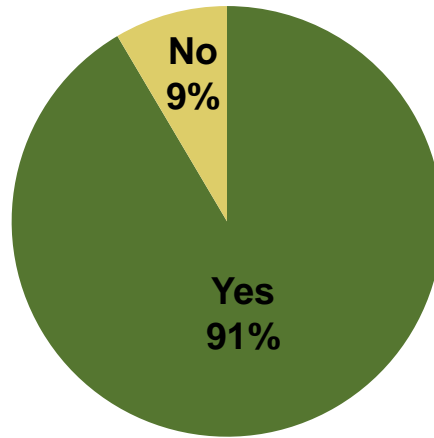

Very Likely Likelly Neutral Unlikely Very Unlikely

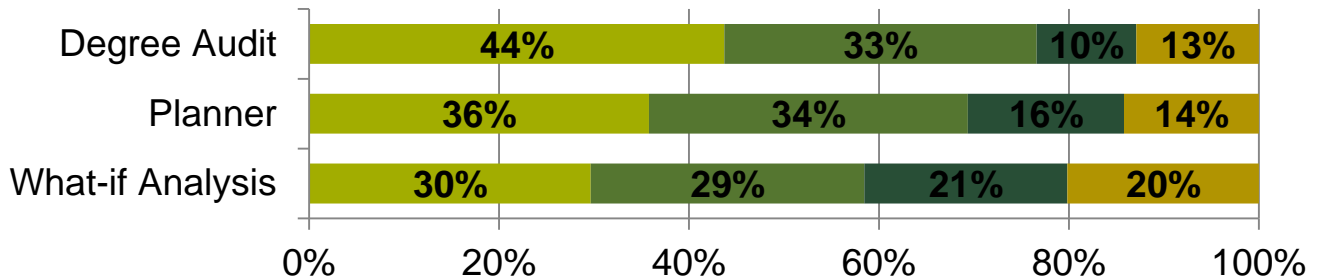


“Have you used Wolverine Track?” (n = 647)



“How often do you use the following functions of Wolverine Track?” (n = 580)

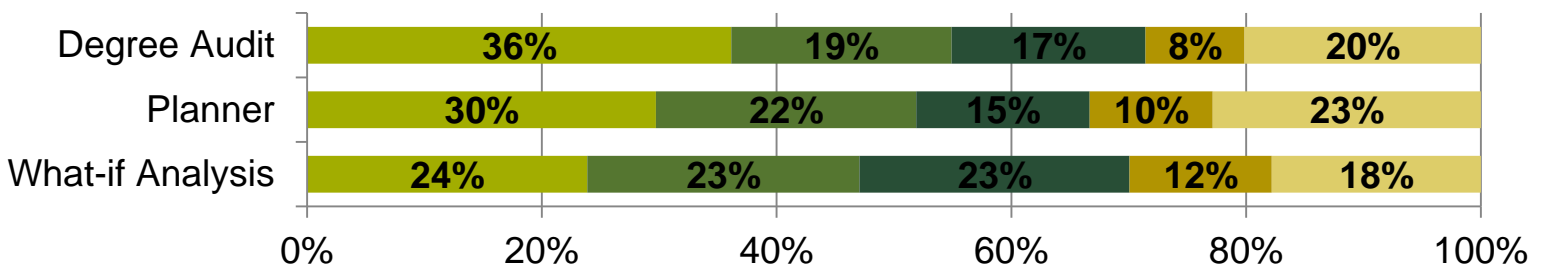
■ Frequently ■ Occasionally ■ Rarely ■ Never
