A.S. Engineering Design Technology (Architectural Drafting and Design Track)

After being admitted to the university, students interested in a career in architecture should declare their major, begin their coursework, and then apply to the Architectural Drafting and Design track of the A.S. in Engineering Design Technology degree. This degree allows a student to pursue entry level employment as a drafter in the architectural industry. Only those who complete this track are eligible for matriculation into the B.Arch degree program.

Applications are submitted during the Spring semester of the first year of coursework.

The UVU Architecture program encourages all applicants to meet faculty and visit the school prior to applying to the program. The Program Coordinator will schedule an open house each spring preceding the application deadline to facilitate this and answer questions.

All application materials will be processed and evaluated by the Bachelor of Architecture Admissions Committee. This committee consists of faculty in the Department of Architecture & Engineering Design
