

Application to the Bachelor of Architecture (B-Arch) degree program at UVU requires completion, or near completion of an approved Associates of Science (A.S). degree in a related field of architecture. The A.S. in Engineering Design Technology currently offered at UVU is the preferred and direct choice. However, students from other colleges are welcome to contact the B-Arch Program Coordinator, and UVU advisors for questions related to transferring credits and applying to the program. Transfer classes will be considered on a case by case basis.

The UVU Architecture program encourages all applicants to schedule a visit and have an informational interview. This interview is optional but encouraged prior to applying to the program. The Program Coordinator will schedule an open house each spring preceding the application deadline to facilitate the interview and answer questions.

All application materials will be processed and evaluated by the Bachelor of Architecture Admissions Committee. This committee consists of faculty in the Department of Architecture & Engineering Design.
