Graduation Requirements

1. Completion of minimum of 120 semester credits, with a minimum of 40 credits of upper division credit.
2. Overall GPA of 3.0 (B) or above with no grade lower than a C in discipline core courses and no grade lower than a B- in licensure and methods courses.
3. Completion of GE and specified departmental requirements.
4. Portfolio submission during senior year.
5. Residency hours: minimum of 30 credits completed through course attendance at UVU; at least 10 hours earned in the last 45 hours.
6. Successful completion of at least 1 Global/Intercultural course.
