- 3. Completion of GE and specified departmental requirements.
- 4. Portfolio submission during senior year.
- 5. Residency hours: minimum of 30 credits completed through course attendance at UVU; at least 10 hours earned in the last 45 hours.
- 6. Successful completion of at least 1 Global/Intercultural course.
