#### Graduation Requirements

1. Completion of minimum of 120 semester credits.
2. Over 2.0+ GPA; with 3.0 or above in Art/Arth courses. Courses within area of emphasis must be completed with a C- grade or above.
3. Residency hours: minimum of 30 credits completed through course attendance at UVU, at least 10 hours earned in the last 45 hours.
4. Completion of General Education and specified department requirements.
5. Graduation Portfolio submission is required during your senior year.
6. Successful completion of at least 1 Global/Intercultural course.
