

Sources of Information and Data at UVU

Tableau

<https://tableau.uvu.edu>

Login with your UV ID and password. Information exists in folders related to content; visibility based on user role/audience.

Information: Enrollment, faculty workload, IRI surveys. Currently used mainly for student and faculty information.

User Experience: Visualizations with filters on various data dimensions; some tables.

Use this tool for: viewing trends and comparing information; Analyzing pre-determined metrics; telling a data “story”.

Argos

Login with your UV ID and password, Select WebViewer option.

Information: Enrollment, faculty workload, finance, HR.

User Experience: Can provide charts and data tables; drill down to detail.

Use this tool for: viewing current state in a chart, retrieving tables of data for further analysis, and providing detailed reports such as financial statements, course rosters, or faculty schedules/workload.

Crystal Reports*

Best viewed with Internet Explorer. Login with your UV ID and password. Click on “Document List” under the “Navigate” menu. Expand the “Public” folder by clicking on the plus sign to its left. All reports will be listed in folders based on the audience and information provided.

Information: Student enrollment, faculty workload, accounts receivable (including course fees), graduations, majors, curriculum, class scheduling, course history, etc.

User Experience: Most reports are provided in Excel, but some are provided via PDF format to insure that data is grouped and presented in an easy-to-read format. Users schedule reports for one-time or repeated runs and the results are delivered to them via e-mail. Most reports also have a good description to help you know what data you’ll receive.

Use this tool for: Retrieving tables of data for further analysis, and providing detailed reports such as course rosters or faculty schedules/workload. This tool has also been used to provide batch files containing user or course information for system integration processes where manual updates are needed.

* Frequently used and critical reports that are now delivered via Crystal Reports are being ported to either Tableau or Argos (or both, depending on the function of the report). We are prioritizing these moves with usage data provided by Crystal Reports, and as reports are available in either Tableau or Argos, the appropriate audience for the information will be notified. After a reasonable time period, the Crystal Report will be archived and no longer available to be scheduled by users.

My.UVU Portal

Login with your UV ID and password.

Information: Various reports and information can be accessed via the my.UVU portal, depending on your role at the institution. Banner self-service functions reside within the portal, and can provide financial, HR, student, faculty, and advisor information in detail or summary form.

User Experience: Information is usually viewed in a webpage, and can consist of tables and lists. You will almost always select a term, and other parameters before you see the information.

Use this tool for: Intended to provide live data from the Banner system to make immediate decisions. Not good for using data in further analyses. If that's what you're looking for, check Argos or Crystal. If you don't find what you need there, ask! We can usually provide something ad hoc and then develop further if it's going to be used more than once or twice.

Institutional Research & Information

Information: Official reports and surveys related to all institutional activities.

User Experience: Information is organized by topic or type of report. Several are visualizations that have been created using Tableau and posted publicly. Older reports are usually in PDF format.

Use this tool for: Retrieving institutional aggregate data, official statistics on academic programs, and survey results.

Targeted Reports via e-mail

Information: Some financial and other transactional reports are generated by our systems such as Banner, and then e-mailed to the appropriate party.

User Experience: Information delivered can be in PDF, Excel, or a text format.

Use this tool for: Monitoring information related to financial and other activities for which you are accountable.
