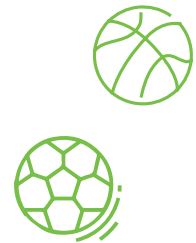

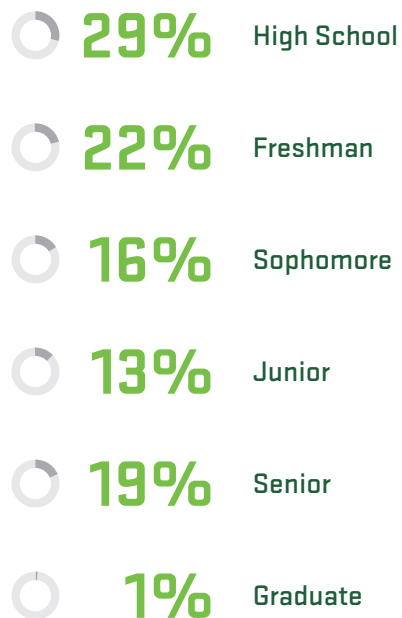

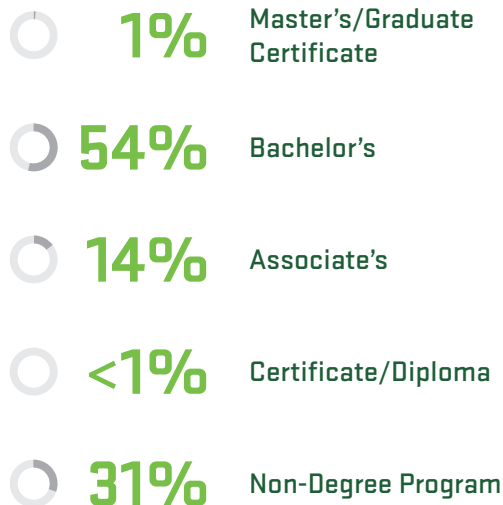

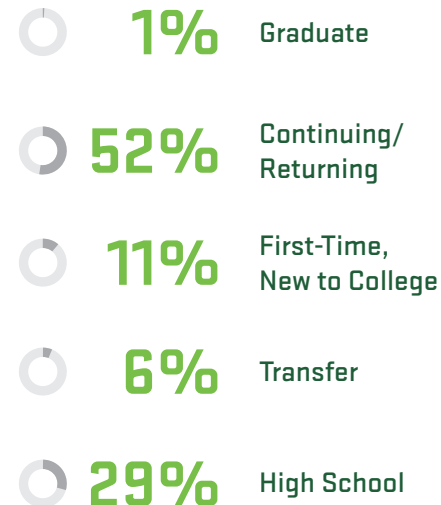
% OF STUDENTS BY CLASS LEVEL

PLACE OF ORIGIN (WHERE STUDENTS ARE FROM AT TIME OF APPLICATION)*

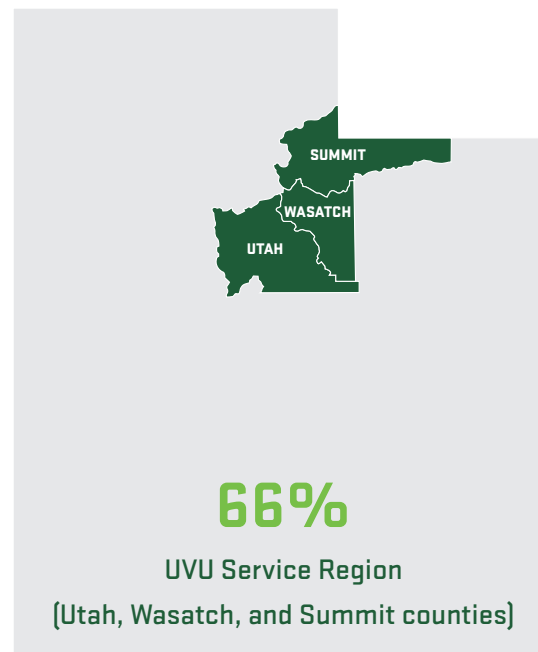

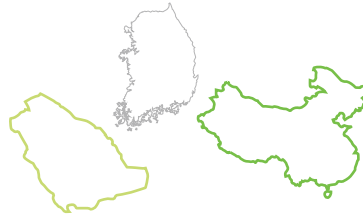




PLACE OF ORIGIN

Saudi Arabia, South Korea, China

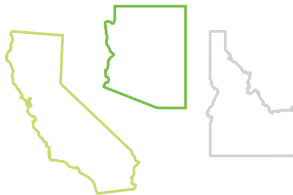

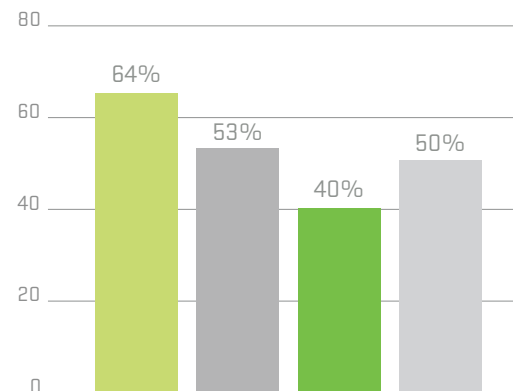
