Community Survey

- UVU conducts a telephone survey of the community every 3-4 years (2008, 2011, 2015)
- Topics include awareness, perceptions, branding, athletics, marketing, etc.
- The 2015 survey is also timed to inform our 75th anniversary
- Margin of error varies by group, but is approximately ±5%
- Topics covered in this presentation:
 - Awareness of UVU and UVU's offerings
 - General perceptions and reputation of UVU






AWARENESS OF UVU

(2015 compared to 2011)


- Technical and vocational certificates
 - Utah county

 (73%→81%) Full State

 (57%→75%)
- Associate's or 2 year degrees
 - Utah county \uparrow (95% \rightarrow 97%) Full State \uparrow (88% \rightarrow 90%)
- Bachelor's degrees
 - Utah county \checkmark (99% → 97%) Full State \checkmark (92% → 87%)
- Master's degrees
 - Utah county ↓ (80%→60%) Full State ↓ (71%→59%)

- Actively interacting with peers and professors; learning from each other





UVU's roles: job training


UVU provides many opportunities for career and job training (Agree or Strongly agree)





UVU's roles: responding to employer needs


UVU responds to the educational needs of employers (Agree or Strongly agree)

As a comprehensive university, UVU continues to serve an important community college role in its region. (Agree or strongly agree)






Progress of UVU's Academic Rigor









UVU's certificates and Associate's degrees

UVU's Bachelor's & Master's degrees


UVU offers degrees which align with community, business, and industry needs. (Agree or strongly agree)

Seeking information about UVU's degrees or programs


Have you ever sought information regarding UVU's degrees or programs? (Yes)

Recommend attending UVU


How likely would you be to select or recommend UVU (attending)? (Likely or very likely)

Key 2015 Take-aways

- Familiarity with UVU has increased
- Awareness of Master's degrees has decreased
- Respondents believe UVU's academic rigor has increased compared to 10 years ago
- Increase in statewide appreciation for UVU's community college role
