- UVU is a dual mission university which means we include a community college within the university.
- Fall Semester 2020 enrollment of 40,936 makes UVU one of the largest universities in the State of Utah.
- Class sizes average 23 students.

- Are adventurous! 38% of our students are First Generation.

 - We have the largest Latino/Latina student enrollment in Utah as a 4-year university with 4,911 students.
