OVERVIEW

This 100% online BSN is designed for RNs with an ASN or AAS in Nursing and can be completed in as little as three semesters.

CREDIT FOR YOUR RN CREDENTIAL

- Earn 36 credits for your RN Credential
- Take 26 credits of Nursing specific courses plus (possibly) 4 credits of "other" (30 credits minimum for residency required)
- Courses include Palliative Care, Nursing in the Community, Nursing in the Community Clinical, Genomics, Global Perspective, Leadership, Clinical Assessment & Reasoning, Navigating Health Systems, Research Theory, Quality and Safety
