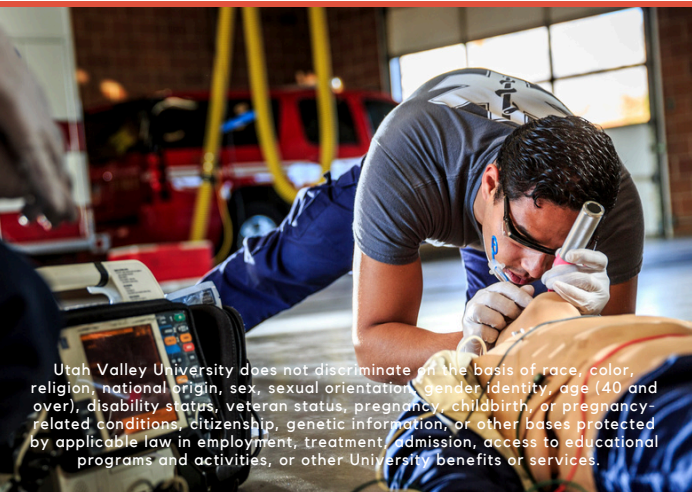
JOB OUTLOOK
