Licensure & Certifications Awarded

- Utah Paramedic license and National Registry certification
- Provider certifications BLS, ACLS, PALS, NRP, AMLS, GEMS, PHTLS, LEFR, and Fundamentals of Airway.

Prerequisites for Application

- 18 years old and valid driver's license
- Utah EMT and CPR certification
- Anatomy and Physiology with a grade of C or higher
- MAT 1020 or MAT 0980 with a C- grade or higher or placement into MAT 1015 or MAT 1035 (QL), with valid scores in ALEKS 19+ or scores in ACT 17+ or SAT 510+.
- ENGH 1005 with a C grade or higher or placement into ENGL 1010 (valid test scores)
 - Highly Recommended to complete a math and Literacy QL requirement.

SCHEDULE

The paramedic program offers two different cohort length options. (All cohorts are 48/96 Fire Department shift schedule friendly. For more information on shift schedules, talk with an advisor.)

Full-Time Program (Complete in 2 semesters)

- Fall/Spring (August-April) and Spring/Summer (January-August)
 - Semester 1: Monday-Friday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. (Except on "A" shift days).
 - Semester 2: Clinicals and field work. Times and locations will vary during the semester.
