

How to transition from UVU Concurrent Enrollment status to UVU Freshman status

Concurrent Enrollment students need to be re-admitted before they can continue taking UVU courses after high school graduation. The re-admission process converts students from Concurrent Enrollment status to undergraduate status.

Steps for re-admission

1. Admissions website www.uvu.edu/admissions
2. Choose: "Undergraduate Application"
3. Login to your profile (if you don't remember your profile email & password, send an email to admissionprocessing@uvu.edu)
4. Choose: Start an Application
5. Choose: "**Concurrent Enrollment to Freshman**" application

Fill out the entire application and submit any required information. This process will switch your status in the UVU system. **Once you have been re-admitted, you will be assigned to a new advisor in your chosen major** (if you are undecided, please choose University Studies as your major). After your status has been changed, you will be required to meet with your new major advisor and complete online orientation. These steps must be complete before you can register for summer or fall classes. Remember to check your UVU student email for all official correspondence.
