

# 9th & 10th Grade GETTING STARTED CHECKLIST

## Determine Eligibility

9th & 10th graders in high school must have:

- 3.0+ cumulative GPA for concurrent enrollment academic courses.
- 2.0+ cumulative GPA for concurrent enrollment CTE courses.
- 3.5+ cumulative GPA for live interactive courses.

In lieu of an accredited school transcript, homeschool students may submit an ACT composite score of 22 or higher for basic eligibility. Per state rule, homeschool students must be enrolled at the high school where they will be taking the course(s).

## Choose Your Courses - Offerings vary by high school

#### ITEMS REQUIRED FOR APPLICATION

- Completed application with all information and signatures  
*incomplete applications will not be accepted*
- High school transcript
- Proof of placement testing

- The UVU Concurrent Enrollment Office registers all high school sophomores & freshmen for college courses.
- Each application is reviewed to determine eligibility for requested courses. Students are notified by email once their application has been processed.

**DEADLINES APPLY**

- Courses cost \$5 per credit hour.
- Submit the Parent Permission Form to your high school concurrent enrollment coordinator or teacher.
