Holds

Tuition Hold (OT), (WO), (CE)

UVU policy requires past tuition to be paid in full before the registration hold can be removed.

If you have a financial hold on your account and you pay your balance in full— your hold will be removed in 1-2 business days if you pay with a debit or credit card. If you pay by check your hold will be removed 7-10 business days after the Cashier's office receives the payment. If you pay by card and wish for the hold to be removed immediately, please reach out to the Cashier's office.

Academic Hold (AW), (AP)

Academic Warning:

- When your college cumulative GPA is above a 2.0, but your semester GPA falls below a 2.0.
- To remove your AW hold, you need to complete the Academic Warning workshop by watching the video and scoring 100% on the quiz.

Academic Probation:

- When your college semester and cumulative GPA fall below a 2.0.
- To remove your AP hold, you need to complete the Academic Probation Workshop and meet with your CE Academic Advisor.

Prerequisite Hold

Students must meet all prerequisites for their classes. Refer to the prerequisite list to know the UVU prerequisites for the course. Refer to your high school coordinator for school specific prerequisites.

Placement exams for English 1010 and Math 1050 can be taken on UVU campus. You can schedule a placement exam through Testing Services.

New Freshmen Hold/ Incorrect Graduation Date

Seniors are auto-admitted to UVU. All new college freshmen who come to UVU will have three holds on their account before they can register for their courses. If you have these holds but you are not in the last half of your high school senior year, your graduation date may not be correct in our records. Have your high school registrar contact concurrent@uvu.edu with your name, name of high school, UVID#, and correct graduation date to get the issue resolved.

- AC: Academic Advisor Clearance- Meet with an advisor in the First-Year Center. Your hold will be removed after your meeting.
- OH: Orientation- All students must complete an online orientation. Plan on taking 1-2 hours to complete it. Your hold will automatically remove when completed.
- JS: Jumpstart- An on-campus orientation experience. After you've signed up for a date, your hold will be removed.

If you have graduated high school but have an HSCE hold that limits you from registering, then you may need to fill out a new application. Email admissionprocessing@uvu.edu or contact Admissions by calling (801) 863-8706 for more specific information.

Incorrect Personal Information

In the case of your personal information (i.e. Name, Birthday, SSN#) being incorrect, you will need to reach out to the Registrar's Office to have this information fixed before you can register for your courses.
