3 police departments Suburb, rural, city 183 full moon days - 256 crimes 5295 non full moon days - 2878 crimes Hypothesis - physiological and psychological changes in body

Bad moon on the rise? Lunar cycles and incidents of crime

The authors cite previous studies showing that a great deal of medical professionals and police officers believe that the full moon does indeed affect behavior and that crime is more likely to happen during a full moon The lunar cycle influences certain opportunities for crime Moon, perhaps through its gravitational pull, affects human behavior itself and compels people to act in ways that they otherwise would not


