#### Literature Review

- No such study has been completed for Utah Valley University specifically
- The most used substance by college students is alcohol, which is used by about 90% of students at least once a year
- Nearly 12% of college students in nationwide surveys reported using one or more types of prescriptions drugs that were not prescribed to them in the past 12 months according to the DEA
- Surveys were the best way to gather information
- Shortfalls are no way to validate information, and low respondent rate







#### Total Responses to Survey

- In total we had 71 people complete the survey
- Out of the 71 people 70 people continued through the end of the survey







#### Sections of the Survey

- We wanted to examine different aspects of drug use among college students who attend UVU
- The Survey had three main sections
- 1. Illegal Drugs
- 2. Prescription Drugs
- 3. Alcohol

#### Illegal Drug Responses

13 out of 70 people reported using Illegal Drugs in their lifetime

Out of the 13 people 4 males and 6 females have admitted to using illegal drugs.


2 preferred not to answer the gender question

One participant put other, but is not counted due to incompletion of the survey.


#### Types of Illegal Drugs Reported

#### Illegal Drug Use and Gender




#### **Drug Use Statistics**

## How long has it been since illegal drugs were used?




#### Drugs on UVU Campus

One person reported Marijuana use on campus, but they did not finish the survey


No people reported distributing drugs on campus


No people reported receiving drugs on campus

### Drug effects on people's everyday lives




#### Prescription Drug Responses






#### **Prescription Drug Effects**

#### Alcohol


I drink alcohol every day





I drink alcohol every month


I have never drank alcohol

#### Conclusions

- Males and Females were equally as likely to try marijuana
- Females and those who prefer not to answer the gender question, in this survey, were more likely to try hard core drugs like cocaine and ecstacy
- In all three categories, illegal drug use, prescription drug use, and Alcohol
  use, people who were employed were more likely to used.
- However, results were inconclusive due to the low response rate and due to respondents not answering some questions
