



## Draper City Police Department Internship

Thank you for your interest in an internship with the Draper City Police Department Crime Scene Investigators/Evidence Technicians.

### REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicants must be currently enrolled at a university with a declared major of Forensic Science or Criminal Justice. You must carry a 3.2 GPA or better.
2. The applicant must have completed or be currently enrolled in an Introduction to Forensic Science and an Introduction to Crime Scene Investigations course before applying.
3. Applicants must be participating in the internship as part of a collegiate "for credit" program.
4. The candidate must submit to and pass a background check conducted by the Draper City Police Department

### AVAILABILITY/SCHEDULE:

Our regular scheduled hours are from 600am-430pm, Monday-Friday. We will work with successful applicants to develop a schedule that works for them within these hours. Callouts may occur at any time outside of regular scheduled hours. While we are understanding of busy schedules, we do expect a reasonable effort be made to respond to callouts.

### WHAT TO EXPECT:

At our department, we have two Crime Scene Investigator/Evidence technicians. Both positions have many duties that fall under management of the evidence room, crime scene and forensic processing (including digital forensics and fingerprint processing). An internship with us will allow you to see and participate in the many duties included in our roles. Please keep in mind that parts of this internship may involve exposure to sensitive or distressing content. Maintaining strict confidentiality regarding all information and materials encountered is required.
