



Computer Science and Software Engineering Matriculation Policy (Catalog years 2015 and later)

In order to take advanced (3000 and higher) Computer Science classes, students are required to complete the following classes with the grades as listed.

CS1400 Minimum grade C+

CS1410 Minimum grade C+

CS2300 Minimum grade C+

CS2420 Minimum grade C+

MATH 1210 Minimum grade C

ENGL 1010 Minimum grade C

Additional Requirements

OVERALL UVU GPA must be at least 2.5

Students may not repeat a class more than once (can't take more than twice)

Changing to Advanced CS Status

Students should meet with their CS advisor after completing all matriculation courses. Advisor will update their matriculation status and add the COSC attribute.

STATUS CATEGORIES

- *Provisional approval:* All requirements have been met with exception of current semester's grades. Students will be provided with minimum acceptable grades for that semester's classes.
- *Probational* (for those students who could get approved with repeat of 1 or more classes) Students will be evaluated each semester until all requirements are complete or dropped from the program.
- *Not approved:* for students who have exhausted repeats and will be dropped from the program.
- *Final approval:* Awarded at end of semester that all requirements have been met.

If CS2420 is completed prior to Calculus, or if a CS class needs to be repeated, students will be allowed to take the following CS classes without being approved for the major. (CS2810, CS2600, CS2550, CS305G)
