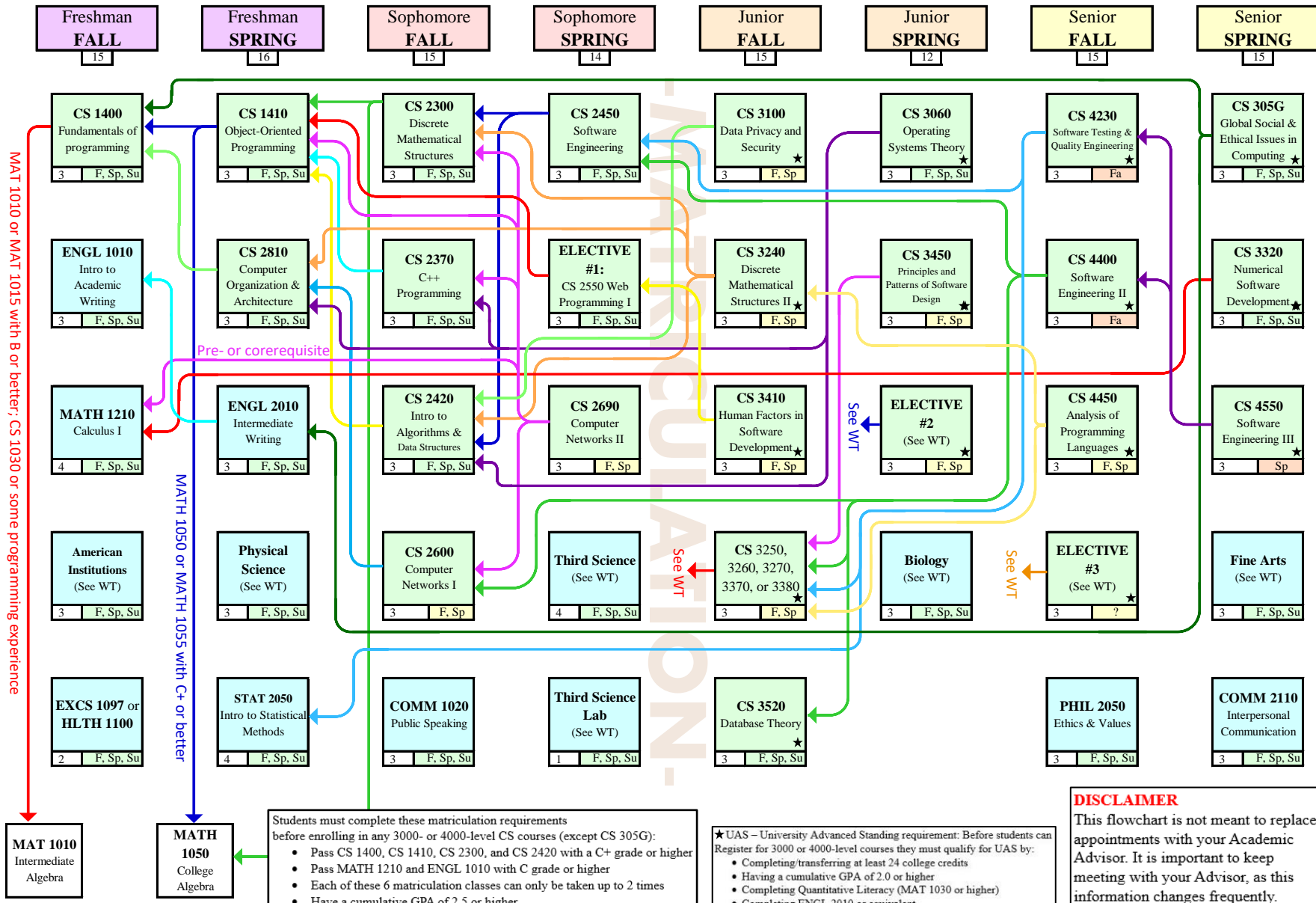


SOFTWARE ENGINEERING (2023-2024)



Students must complete these matriculation requirements before enrolling in any 3000- or 4000-level CS courses (except CS 305G):

- Pass CS 1400, CS 1410, CS 2300, and CS 2420 with a C+ grade or higher
- Pass MATH 1210 and ENGL 1010 with C grade or higher
- Each of these 6 matriculation classes can only be taken up to 2 times
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher

★UAS – University Advanced Standing requirement: Before students can Register for 3000 or 4000-level courses they must qualify for UAS by:

- Completing/transferring at least 24 college credits
- Having a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Completing Quantitative Literacy (MAT 1030 or higher)
- Completing ENGL 2010 or equivalent
