

## CULINARY ARTS INSTITUTE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

We are fortunate to be able to offer Culinary Arts Institute Scholarships to qualifying students each semester. These scholarships are earned, not awarded. Applicants are expected to be in good academic standing, be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours, and have completed CA 1120 Cooking Skills Development and CA 1170 Pastry & Baking Skills or will be enrolled in for the semester applying for the scholarship. All CA students who meet the criteria will be considered for a scholarship. Each application will be carefully reviewed by our Scholarship Committee. The application process is outlined below.

Application deadlines are on the last Friday of the following months:

FALL SEMESTER-----August  
SPRING SEMESTER-----December  
SUMMER SEMESTER-----April

To qualify for a Culinary Arts Institute Scholarship, the applicant will be scored based on the following:

- Cumulative GPA
- Financial Need
- Engagement in Community and/or UVU sanctioned competitions (such as: Skills USA, NICCO Cup, and ACF certifications).
- Community Service
- Employment in the industry
- Involvement with MTECH, Pro-start, Culinary Arts programs, or cooking classes in high school
- Current ServSafe Manager Certificate
- Class Contribution/Attitude

**Please submit the following (if applicable):**

- (1) A completed Culinary Arts Institute Scholarship Application (this form).
- (2) A one-page letter of intent explaining your personal and professional goals, reasons for choosing this area of emphasis, and financial need.
- (3) Two letters of recommendation from past or current employers.
- (4) Documentation of completed employment hours in the culinary field (may consist of copies of pay stubs or a letter from your employer giving dates of employment and average number of hours worked per week).
- (5) Documentation of participation in competitions, awards for volunteering, certifications, etc.
