

Instructions for delayed matriculation appeals form:

“Students are required to officially audition for matriculation at the end of their first year in the program. Students who miss the audition or, who do not demonstrate the requisite skills for the major, will be required to make a formal appeal to the Department Chair and Program Coordinator, in order to audition at the end of the next academic year. In addition, students will receive a joint letter from the Program Coordinator and the Chair informing them of their progress.”

Complete the following steps:

1. Complete Appeals Form.
2. Compose letter to the UVU Dance Department explaining, in detail, why you are requesting delayed matriculation. Letter should be no longer than one page.
3. Schedule meeting with your program coordinator to discuss delayed matriculation. Appointment must be completed prior to March 29, 2019.
4. Submit appeal form and letter to your program coordinator.
5. Appeal will be received by your program coordinator and subsequently discussed with the department chair.
6. Students will receive a letter from the Dance Department stating whether or not the appeal was accepted.
