INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR APPLICATION

We are delighted you will be attending Utah Valley University. Your application for aid is welcome. This form is for **Ballet Tuition Waiver Scholarships**. To be considered, you must meet the following conditions:

1. Be a Utah resident or non-resident. NOTE: Non-resident funding is limited.
2. Be a high school graduate and have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 or 3.0 to be considered for a Dean's Merit scholarship, or;
3. Be a continuing student who has completed a minimum of 12 credit hours at UVU and have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 or 3.0 to be considered for a Dean's Merit scholarship.
4. Be approved by the academic school in which the scholarship is offered.
5. If you receive a scholarship, you must enroll for the complete 12 credit hours each term the award covers.
6. Be registered for applicable ballet courses.
7. Have declared status for the AS Dance Emphasis or BFA in Dance – Ballet Emphasis.
8. Have no previous semester scholarship default.

In addition to completing this form, you also must submit/complete the following:

1. Attend the Ballet Scholarship audition and complete the technique class.
2. Submit a current transcript.
3. Submit a letter of recommendation from someone with whom you have worked extensively in dance.
4. Submit a letter of intent in which you articulate what you intend to do with/in dance while a student at UVU and beyond.

If you are awarded a dance scholarship, you will be notified by the UVU Scholarship office, via an email through your myUVU account, instructions on how to go online and accept your award. If you are not awarded a dance scholarship, you will receive notification from the Department of Dance.

Whether or not you qualify for this award, you should consider applying for other financial aid as well. You may be able to receive additional help through Pell Grant or other grants, with work-study (part-time employment), from student loans.
