It is strongly advised this exam be taken at least 4 months prior to the program application deadline allowing time for any repeats. •Allow yourself a minimum of 5 weeks study time •Exam is offered every month on a continuous basis •Dates subject to change, check website for most current •Cost of exam is \$170.00 •Passing score: Language Arts: 157, Math: 157, Social Studies: 155, Science: 159 •Exam repeatable at \$60 per section every 29 days •When sitting for the exam, you will be given the option of having the exam results sent to various institutions.
