Students must have majored in one of the 17 teaching content areas UVU offers: Art & Visual Comm.; ASL and Deaf Studies; Biology; Business/Marketing; Chemistry; Dance; Earth Science; English; French; Health; History- Social Studies; Math; Music; PE Teacher; Physics; Spanish; or Theater.

Students who have majored in one of these content areas can then work toward a Utah teaching license. In addition to the required coursework through the School of Education, the teaching methods course for the content area must be completed prior to student teaching in the program.
