The Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course is a major component of the Associate of Science degree in Emergency Services. Results from the EMT National Registry Exam are used as a measure of program success. In 2015, Utah moved from a state exam for Emergency Medical Technicians to the National Registry Exam. It has taken three years for results to move above the 80% level.
