- USHE policy R485 eliminates S11 workload calculator, giving institutions authority to define instructional hour equivalents (IHE) and workload models tailored to their needs
  - Recommended forming a new task force, with subcommittees by college, to define IHE, address discipline-specific needs, and propose policy revisions
  - Policy 641 is already open for revision, but further changes are on hold pending recommendations from the new task force
  - Senate voted to support forming the joint task force
