Important Goals:

General Education

- Meet the Essential Learning Outcomes as Specified in the R470
- Seamless Transfer In and Out of UVU (maybe not course-by-course by category-by-category)
- Limited Choice Too Much to Choose From = Decreased Persistence, Excess Credits
- Success in Courses in First Semester/with Support, if Needed

Other:

- Pathways: Students Feel They are Studying What They are Interested in Studying (at least in one course in each of the first two semesters)
- High Impact Practice (HIP) for Every Student in the First 30 Semester Hours (likely General Education)
