UVU Undergraduate Courses

Utah Valley University (UVU) offers full-time, benefits-eligible employees undergraduate resident tuition and general student fees waived for up to eighteen (18) credit hours each semester.

UVU also offers undergraduate resident tuition waivers (fees not included) to dependents of full-time, benefits-eligible employees — spouse and unmarried (never married) children up to age 26.

Hourly staff members may be eligible for up to three (3) credit hours, or one (1) class of undergraduate resident tuition and general student fees waived each semester.

Adjunct faculty are eligible for undergraduate resident tuition and general student fees waived equal to the amount of credit hours taught in the semester.

Graduate Tuition Assistance for Staff

The Professional Association of Campus Employees (PACE) manages a fund to assist full-time staff members pursuing a Master's or Doctorate degree, or professional certification in an area related to their current position. Funds are awarded yearly after an application is submitted. The award amount cannot exceed \$1,500 per year, with a \$4,500 lifetime limit. Funds can be used to reimburse employees following the completion of a course with a 'B' grade or better, or upon completion of certification.
