

Current COVID-19 Quarantine/Isolation Process

These are the current COVID-19 quarantine/isolation processes but are subject to change at any time.

If unaware of vaccination status, un-vaccinated procedure will be followed.

Vaccinated

Exposure

- UVU does not require quarantine for exposure (unless positive test result or symptomatic).

Symptomatic (ill)

- No COVID-19 test
 - UVU requests employees stay off-campus when symptomatic (ill).
 - No isolation length requirement unless positive test result.
 - Employee may return 24 hours after they are no longer symptomatic.
- Negative test result
 - Employee would follow standard leave procedure and use accrued paid leave time.
- Positive test result
 - Employee to self-isolate for 10 calendar days from the start of symptoms and follow standard leave procedures.
 - Employee to fill out [COVID-19 Self-Reporting form](#). Contact tracer will reach out to discuss the next steps.

Un-Vaccinated

Exposure

- UVU requests quarantine for 7-10 days.
 - Employee to fill out [COVID-19 Self-Reporting form](#). Contact tracer will reach out to discuss the next steps.
 - If negative test on day 7, employee may return that day.
 - If not tested, employee may return after day 10 (on day 11).

Symptomatic (ill)

- No COVID-19 test
 - UVU requests employees stay off-campus when symptomatic (ill).
 - Employee to fill out [COVID-19 Self-Reporting form](#) if symptoms are in line with COVID-19. Contact tracer will reach out to discuss next steps.
- Negative test result
 - Employee would follow standard leave procedure and use accrued leave time unless requested to quarantine or isolate.
- Positive test result
 - Employee to self-isolate for 10 days from the start of symptoms or positive test date and follow standard leave procedures
 - Employee to fill out [COVID-19 Self-Reporting form](#) if symptoms are in line with COVID-19. Contact tracer will reach out to discuss next steps.
