is an important part of the Planning, Budget, and Human Resources (PBHR) division. We span a variety of services including data collection, institutional reporting, and analysis of institutional data.

WHAT WE PROVIDE:

DATA COLLECTION, RESEARCH, AND COLLABORATION

We coordinate, collect, manage, analyze, and communicate information to promote student success and support decision makers—including executives, faculty, staff, and students.

What that means for you:

- IR provides a repository of official institutional information on their website in the form of fact books and other press-ready snapshots.
- IR interfaces with outside databases of information about UVU and students, such as IPEDS, The Department of Workforce Services, and the National Student Clearinghouse.
- IR can provide official data to support PBA requests, grants, public publications, and press releases.
- IR can help validate other information regarding UVU as needed.



CRITICAL DECISION-MAKING SUPPORT

We provide timely and useful information for decision and planning support which both responds to and anticipates the needs of institutional leaders. We also provide insight into regional and national trends in higher education and its environment, the best practices of other institutions, and critical appraisals of various techniques, tools, and instruments used to describe institutional information.

OFFICIAL REPORTING AND DATA COORDINATION

We collaborate, facilitate, and conduct both quantitative and qualitative data collection and research activities for and with administration, staff, faculty, and students. We provide guidance and coordination to individuals and offices in their research efforts.

- IR facilitates survey research, focus groups, and other data collection efforts
- IR collaborates with the Office of Academic Research Support (OARS) and the Institutional Review Board (IRB).
