

GETTING TO KNOW YOUR TERMINAL



1 Audio keys

To reduce station speaker or handset volume

Listen OK:


to share a conversation

Listen ok

To increase station speaker or handset volume

Menu key - used to program your terminal.

- 3 **Display** one line display offers access to several pages of call information.
- 4 Keys and Corresponding LEDs these keys (symbol:) are either line keys or function keys, and have corresponding LEDs.



- 5 Light indicates messages or callback requests.
- 6 END key used to terminate a call or programming.

LED - CALL AND FUNCTION INDICATION:

LED is flashing:

Incoming call.

Call on hold.

LED is solid:

Call in progress.

Call on common hold.

PRE-PROGRAMMED KEYS - are used to:

: access a line, enter a feature code while in conversation

: access the various message services

call using your personal directory

HOLD : put a call on hold


conference : talk with two other people at the same time (3-way conference call)

redial the last number dialed

transfer a call to another terminal

INSTALLING THE LABEL ON THE TERMINAL:

A printed label is supplied with the terminal. This should be installed between the rows of keys.



- ① Insert a flat blade into the slot.
- 2 Raise the cover.
- 3 Slide the printed label into position.
- Replace the cover.

ADJUSTING DISPLAY VIEWING ANGLE:




Enter code for the "Display - adjustment" feature



YOUR CALLS (making a telephone call)



is displayed.

YOUR CALLS (handling several calls)

CALLING ANOTHER NUMBER DURING A CALL



Press a free LINE kev.







'Speed Dial'

(The first call is automatically put on hold 1

ACCEPTING A SECOND CALL



Caller's name is displayed.



LINE key for LED which is flashing. (multi-line terminal)

(The first call is automatically put on hold)

TRANSFERRING A CALL



Dial the No. of the terminal to receive the transferred call.



Press TRANSFER

SWITCHING BETWEEN ONE CALL AND ANOTHER (Broker)



OR



LINE key for LED which is solid (multi-line terminal)

(The alternate call is automatically put on hold)

(single-line terminal) THREE-WAY CONFERENCE

to set up a 3-way call.

When in conversation with one party, and another call is on hold, you can:



Press the CONFERENCE key

To cancel the 3-way call - use the same procedure...

to return to the first call.

IN YOUR ABSENCE

FORWARDING YOUR CALLS TO ANOTHER NUMBER (Forwarding - immediate)



Dial the No. of the terminal receiving the fowarded call

(Forwardina is acknowledged on the display)



System acknowledges forwarding and displays the number receiving the forward.

FORWARDING YOUR CALLS TO A VOICE MESSAGE SYSTEM

CHECKING YOUR MESSAGES

Light and corresponding LED indicate messages are waiting for you:

• Callback (to answer callback requests left on your station)




