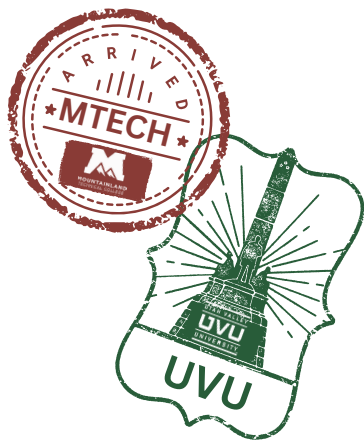

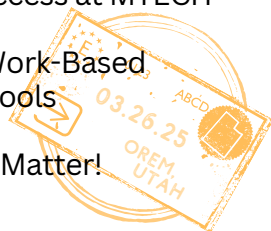

A Junior High & Middle School Counselor's Guide to Future Career Success at MTECH: Mountainland Technical College (MTECH) offers exciting career pathways, and junior high counselors play a key role in student preparation. This session provides essential tools to guide students and parents in preparing for MTECH programs in high school.

AI in School Counseling: Innovative Strategies and Resources: Explore the transformative power of AI in school counseling during this engaging breakout session. Designed for counselors eager to enhance their programs, this session will provide practical ideas on integrating AI into various aspects of counseling work.

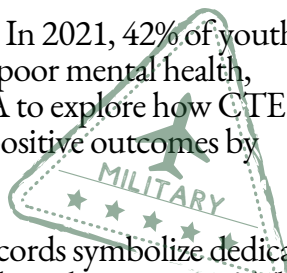

CTE as a Protective Factor for Mental Health: In 2021, 42% of youth reported persistent sadness, and 29% experienced poor mental health, according to the YRBS. This session offers a Q&A to explore how CTE programs enhance mental health, resilience, and positive outcomes by fostering protective relationships.

CTE Pathways: Why Cords Matter!: Pathway cords symbolize dedication, skill mastery, and career readiness, but do they truly make an impact? This session explores their role in motivating students, celebrating achievement, and proving their value beyond just recognition.

From High School to Higher Ed: Mastering Transfer Credits and Pathways: Explore credit articulation, dual enrollment, and strategies to help students maximize their academic potential. Learn how to navigate the transition from high school to higher education efficiently, saving time and money.

Helping Students Feel Confident Choosing a College: A UVU Update
With rising doubts about higher education's value, students question if college is worth the investment. This session explores higher education's benefits and highlights UVU as a strong option for students.

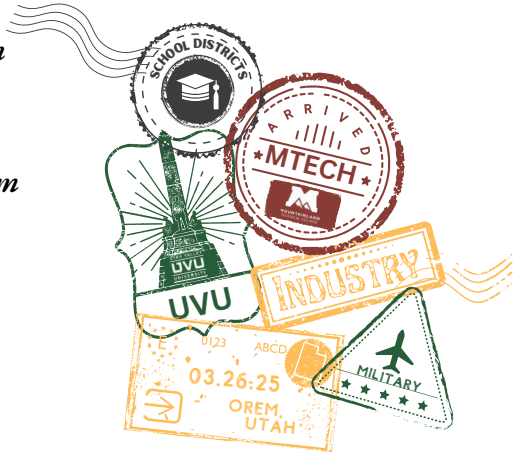
