

# Instructions for the YouScience Aptitude Activity

If you would like to create your own aptitude activity, follow these simple steps to make it easy and fun!

## Step 1: Use an AI Program

Utilize an AI tool like ChatGPT to generate creative and engaging aptitude-based descriptions.

## Step 2: Gather Aptitude Data

Copy the aptitude data from one of these fliers:

## Step 3: Create Your Prompt

Input the aptitude data into ChatGPT with a fun and creative prompt. Here are some examples:

- Use these aptitudes to describe **10 movie adventurers**
- Use these aptitudes to describe **the skills needed to play 10 board games**
- Use these aptitudes to describe **10 different types of teachers**
- Use these aptitudes to describe **10 different cartoon characters**
- Use these aptitudes to describe **10 professional athletes**

You get the idea! Last year, we aligned aptitudes with ice cream flavors and pizza toppings for fun. It is much more engaging to associate them with tangible people, roles, or skills as mentioned above.

## Step 4: Print and Display the Activity

Use Canva to create a cover for 10 lunch sacks with each sack representing one of your aptitude results. (Share with us and save it back into the [Shared Utah Folder](#)!) This activity draws people to you and gives you an easy way to talk about aptitudes and YouScience.

## Step 5: Encourage Participation with a Fun Drawing

- Participants enter the drawing by placing their name into one of the sacks.
- A winner is drawn from each sack to receive a themed gift card, such as:
  - **Maverik Gift Cards** – "Adventure's first stop!"
  - **Handel's Ice Cream**
  - **Local pizza places**
