The Curriculum and Instruction, M.Ed. is an applied graduate program designed for practicing educational leaders. This program focuses on enhancing instructional practice through advanced coursework in curriculum design, assessment, pedagogy, research methods, and data analysis. This program prepares educators to lead in classrooms, schools, and instructional teams. Students are allowed to transfer nine credits of 5000-level endorsement coursework (awarded by an academic institution for a USBE approved endorsement) to apply toward graduation requirements.

Admission Requirements

- Verification of a bachelor’s degree from an accredited institution
 - A cumulative minimum GPA of 3.0 or a GPA of 3.0 for the last 60 credits of undergraduate coursework
- Three professional references who will provide recommendations through the application portal
 - Submission of complete graduate application and essay
 - A successful interview with the SOE Graduate Committee

Continuance and Graduation Requirements

- Complete all courses with a grade of C- or higher, and an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher
 - Complete all program hours (30)
 - Complete courses and project requirements within six years
- A minimum of 21 graduate credit hours must be completed at UVU in accordance with applicable University and USHE policies at the time of graduation
 - Successfully complete a graduate project that is accepted by the School of Education Graduate Committee.
