Graduate Certificate in Secondary Teaching

The graduate certificate in secondary teaching is designed for individuals who have earned a bachelor's degree in one of the following areas and wish to qualify for teacher licensure through the Utah State Board of Education (USBE).

Students who complete the graduate certificate in secondary teaching at UVU may continue graduate coursework to earn a Master of Education degree (MEd) with an emphasis in secondary teaching.

Please note: Applicants must have completed a USBE-approved education methods course in their content area prior to their student teaching in secondary education.



- 29 credits of coursework
- Three-semester program designed with summer and evening coursework (Students enrolled in this program must be available during the day to complete practicum hours and student teaching in local schools.)
- The 18 emphasis credits earned in the graduate certificate program can be applied toward an M.Ed. in secondary teaching from UVU (Students who choose to pursue their master's degree will be required to complete an additional 12 credit



Admission Requirements

- Verification of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution in a recognized content area (or equivalent coursework) for which UVU can recommend a secondary teaching license Refer to <u>schools.utah.gov/li-</u> <u>censing/endorsements</u> to determine if you have the USBE content area courses required for a secondary teaching endorsement.
- A grade of C or higher for all coursework required by the USBE for a content area major
- A cumulative minimum GPA of 3.0 or a GPA of 3.0 for the last 60 credits of university coursework

- Passing scores from the Praxis II subject area test(s)
- If you earn your teaching license in the same area you received your bachelor's degree, you do not need to meet this requirement.
- A successful background check through the USBE
- Three professional references who will provide recommendations through the application portal
- A successful interview with the School of Education Graduate Committee
- Submission of complete graduate application and admissions essay

Continuance and MEd in Secondary Teaching Graduation Requirements

- Complete all 30 MEd program hours
 - 21 UVU graduate certificate credits
 - 9 additional M.Fd. credits.
- Complete all courses with a grade of B- or higher

- Maintain an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Successfully complete a graduate project that is accepted by the School of Education Graduate Committee
- Complete courses and project requirements within five years
